317 **SAMUEL SNOW**<sup>5</sup> (Jabez<sup>4-3</sup>, Constance<sup>2</sup> Hopkins, Stephen<sup>1</sup>) b. Eastham 22 Jan. 1708/9; d. prob. Eastham bet. 17 July 1775 and 15 March 1784.

He m. Eastham 12 Oct. 1732 **ELIZABETH FREEMAN**, b. there 4 March 1714/15; d. after 15 March 1784; dau. of Samuel and Mary (Paine) Freeman [see no. 175], a desc. of Pilgrims Stephen Hopkins and William Brewster and a second cousin once removed of husband Samuel. The will of Samuel Freeman, dated 28 Jan. 1750/51, mentioned dau. Elizabeth Snow.

Samuel Snow was mentioned in the 1743 will of his father Jabez. This family res. at Eastham.

The will of Samuel Snow of Eastham, dated 17 July 1775 and proved 15 March 1784, remembered wife Elizabeth; deceased son Samuel and his children: Samuel, Joshua and Abigail; daughter-in-law Sarah, wife of said deceased son; sons Joseph (executor), Sparrow, Freeman and Barnabas; daus. Abigail, Mercy, Betty, Mary and Phebe. On 5 May 1784, John Doane of Eastham was named guardian of Joshua Snow, Abigail Freeman and Samuel Snow in the right of their father Samuel Snow, late of Boston, Suffolk Co., and their grandfather Samuel Snow, late of Eastham.

318 **PHEBE SNOW**<sup>5</sup> (Jabez<sup>4-3</sup>, Constance<sup>2</sup> Hopkins, Stephen<sup>1</sup>) b. prob. Eastham ca. 1713; d. prob. Eastham bet. 23 June 1752 and 5 Sept. 1765.

She m., int. rec. Eastham 11 Sept. 1736, **JOHN SMITH**, called "Jr." in rec. of marriage int.; b. Eastham 13 March 1712/13; d. there not long bef. 17 May 1754; son of John and Sarah (-----) Smith. Son John was mentioned in the 1 Dec. 1742 will of John Smith of Eastham.

Dau. Phebe Smith was remembered in the 1743 will of her father Jabez Snow, but she was not identified as "wife of David" in said will, as erroneously stated in print.

Administration of the estate of John Smith, late of Eastham, yeoman, was granted 17 May 1754 to Silvanus Snow [undoubtedly Phebe's brother; see no. 315] and Phebe Smith, widow. Guardianship of Silvanus, Heman, Zerviah and Betty Smith, minor children of John Smith, late of Eastham, yeoman, was granted to Phebe Smith of Eastham on 23 June 1752. Distribution of the estate of John Smith, late of Eastham, was made 5 Sept. 1765 to John Smith Jr., eldest son; sons Silvanus and Heman Smith, and daus. Phebe, Elizabeth, Ruth and Zerviah.
